- 7 (a) Describe what happened when Herod Agrippa I imprisoned Peter. [6]
- (b) Explain what this incident teaches about:
- (i) the nature of Herod Agrippa **and**
- (ii) the nature of God. [12]
- 8 (a) Describe the events involving Paul and Silas when they visited Thessalonica. [6]
- (b) Discuss the vices that can be seen from the behaviour of the Jews who accused Paul in Acts. [12]
